VERY IMPORTANT NOTICE – PLEASE READ

On the following two weekends, **July 24-25 and July 31-August 1**, we will not be able to use St. Stanislaus Church. This is because the new floor will take that amount time for the necessary “curing”. Originally, we intended to cover the area between the Church and the rectory (the courtyard) with a huge tent and have our usual Masses “under the tent”. However, the diocesan attorneys strongly discouraged this approach for “liability reasons.”

Our alternative is to use **St. Patrick Church**.

Obviously, St. Patrick Church is much smaller than St. Stanislaus. Therefore, we have added some additional times for these weekends:

Saturday: 4:00 p.m.
5:30 p.m.
Sunday: 8:00 a.m.
9:00 a.m.
11:00 a.m.

While St. Patrick Church is not, strictly speaking, “handicapped accessible” on the upper level, we will place folding chairs on the lower level and bring Communion to those on that level who are receiving.

Remember this is only for a brief period of two weekends.
